THINGS TO DO


Whether you're looking to get active or to have a day of leisure, Westlake has plenty of ways for you to get outside and enjoy Austin.

With multiple entrance points, creeks to cool off in and over 12 miles of trails, **the greenbelt** is a great place to spend an active afternoon.



If it's a Friday night in the fall, catch a **Westlake High School Football Game**. The talented 5A team is hard to beat.

For a great view of the lake and the downtown skyline, hike up to the **overlook at the Pennybacker Bridge**.



Take a boat out on **Lake Austin**. Drop anchor in a party cove, dock at a lake-front restaurant or take in the views of the numerous houses along the hillsides.

Stop by **Midway Food Truck Park** off Loop 360 for a wide variety of food trucks. There's a playground for the kids and live music on the weekends. Insider tip: you can bring your own cooler!
