In the identified area, the current year population is 17,414. In 2020, the Census count in the area was 15,225. The rate of change since 2020 was 3.21% annually. Persons of Hispanic origin represent 38.0% of the population in the identified area compared to 19.6% of the U.S. population. Persons of Hispanic Origin may be of any race. The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 76.1 in the identified area, compared to 72.5 for the U.S. as a whole.

The household count in this area has changed from 5,309 in 2020 to 6,044 in the current year, a change of 3.10% annually. The five-year projection of households is 6,406, a change of 1.17% annually from the current year total. Average household size is currently 2.87, compared to 2.86 in the year 2020. The number of families in the current year is 4,368 in the specified area.

Current median household income is \$106,622 in the area, compared to \$79,068 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$119,382 in five years, compared to \$91,442 all U.S. households.

Current average household income is \$132,908 in this area, compared to \$113,185 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$153,981 in five years, compared to \$130,581 for all U.S. households.

Current per capita income is \$46,132 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$43,829. The per capita income is projected to be \$54,992 in five years, compared to \$51,203 for all U.S. households.

2024 Socioeconomic Status Index

Currently, 68.4% of the 6,169 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 29.6%, renter occupied; and 2.0% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.9% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.1% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 5,437 housing units in the area and 2.4% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 3.02%. Median home value in the area is \$381,093, compared to a median home value of \$355,577 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.62% annually to \$413,043.

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
